1	The total number of sections for Bal Vatika is restricted to 06 (02 each for Bal Vatika I,II & III respectively). Further, the total number of sections for classes 1st to 10th shall be restricted to 24 only. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Any further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of 500 sq ft and greater in dimension.
2	The school has not uploaded the renewed documents on its website in MPD (Mandatory public Disclosure)link in compliance of circular no 09/2021 for access to the general public. School is directed to upload all the mandatory public documents and information on its website in MPD link to be directly accessible by the public. The compliance be uploaded on SARAS portal within 03 months.
3	The school has constructed toilets for staff on the backside and for students on the right side of the school building restricting the passage for emergency vehicles around the school building. The passage around the school building should be kept free from all obstruction for use of emergency vehicles in emergent situations. School is directed to remove the obstructions and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
4	The computer lab has only 25 computers whereas a minimum of 40 computer nods with net connectivity is required as per the SoPs and board guidelines vide circular no 11/2022. School is directed to upgrade the computer lab and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
5	The outdoor sports facilities are arranged on the hard ground covered with tiles which is not suitable and recommended for outdoor sports being accident prone and not recommended as per Board guidelines and SoPs for sports vide circular no 11/2022. School should follow the

	SoPs and provide for sports specific facilities and infrastructure and upload the compliance with video link on SARAS portal within 03 months.
6	The ramps made for entrance at the school building are without side railings. Further, the CwSN toilets on the second floor and the another building block are not as per the guidelines. Campus should be CwSN accessible with CwSN facilities at each floor and in each block separately for boys and girls. School should follow the circular no 05/2023 and arrange the CwSN facilities in the campus in each block and at each floor as per rule 4.7.3 of affiliation bye laws and the guidelines and upload the compliance on SARAS portal with video link within 03 month.
7	School has not affixed the signage for gender (boys/girls) on toilets arranged in second building block. School should affix the permanent signage with gender specific facilities and comply with the provisions of rule specific toilets in compliance of rule 4.7.2 of the affiliation bye laws and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
8	School shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from CoE, CBSE, Vijayawada and shall upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months .

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.



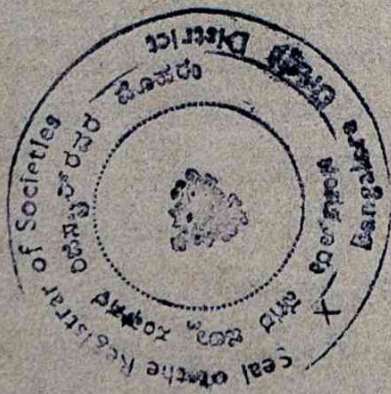
